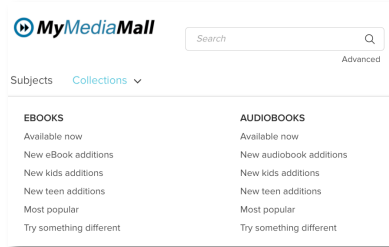


FIND BOOKS

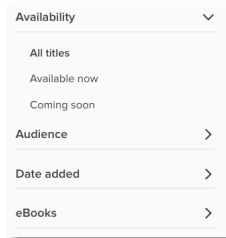
If you have a Kindle Fire, you can use the OverDrive app to download library e-books. **See the “E-Books for Mobile Devices” instructions.**

1 Visit the library’s downloadables page, **MyMediaMall.net**. In the top right corner of the page, **Sign In** with your library name and library card number.

2 Use the Subjects, Collections, or Search options along the top of the page to browse or search for a book.

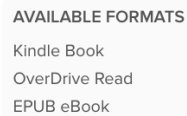


3 In your results, look for the filter to limit titles to only those currently available. You can also sort by format and subject.



4 If an item is checked out, you can **Place a Hold**; if it is available, you can select **Borrow**.

5 Select an item that has the **Kindle Book Format** available. This information appears on the right side of the page.



6 If the item is checked out, you can **place a hold**; if it is available, you can **borrow**. Once borrowed, **Go to Bookshelf** to download your book.

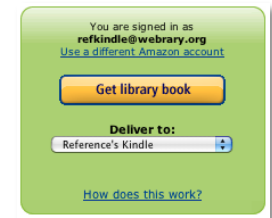
DOWNLOAD BOOK

1 At your bookshelf, under the **Download** drop down menu, click **Kindle Book**.



This will take you to the Amazon website, where you will need to sign in to your Amazon account.

2 Under **Deliver to:** choose your preferred device. Then click **Get library book**.



3 You will then see a confirmation screen, and the book will be sent wirelessly to your Kindle the next time you connect it to Wi-Fi and sync.

4 Once downloaded, you can read the book on your device.
