



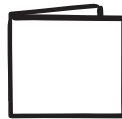
## Short Creative Works by/for YOU.

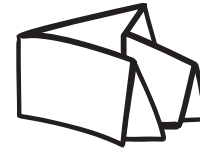
### HOW TO FOLD A MINI ZINE



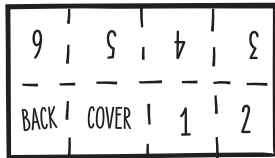
Fold paper hot dog style



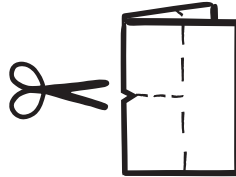
Fold hamburger style



Fold hamburger style again



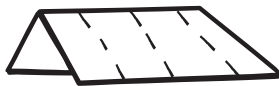
Unfold the paper and check your layout



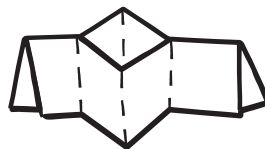
Fold the paper hamburger style and cut halfway on the crease



Unfold. You should have a hole in the middle



Fold paper hot dog style again



Pop the center panels apart



Fold it up and you have a mini zine!

### GUIDELINES

- Include your name or a pen name.
- ✘ Do not put your contact info on your zine.
- Your zine should look good printed on a copier.
- ◆ Submit complete zines only – feel free to take your time.
- ◀ Only submit works that you feel comfortable being read by other people.
- Keep in mind that materials in Youth Services are for Grades 8 and under.
- ⚡ Please limit your submissions to two zines per month.

\* Zines will be selected for display by librarians. We will keep all the originals on file.
