How to Get a Library Card

Identification and proof of residency are required to register for a card. Identification and proof of residency may be provided with a photo ID showing a current address. If a photo ID is unavailable, two forms of ID showing proof of residency are required.

Photo Identification may be provided with:

- Illinois Driver's License
- Illinois State ID
- Mexican Consulate ID
- Military ID Passport

The following are acceptable forms of address verification:

- Checks/Bank statement
- Current Lease/Mortgage
- Auto Registration or Insurance Card
- Property Tax Bill
- Bills
- School ID
- Voter's Registration
